1. Structured feedback and Review of learning outcomes:-

Feedback is a vital part of the teaching-learning process. The college has developed an offline / online feedback system. The analysis of the effectiveness of teaching learning is made through the stakeholder's feedback mechanism. It helps the mentor to recognize that how the students know his or her subject being taught. The collection and analysis of feedback from different stakeholder assist the institution to understand the need of society and what other stakeholders foresee from the college.

2. Review of Lectures, Assignments, promotion of ICT in Teaching-Learning

In order to improve the quality of teaching-learning process, IQAC has recommended to implement random lecture observation system in the college. The responsibility for the same has been taken by the Heads of the department, selected senior faculty members. After observation of the lecture the necessary quality improvement inputs are being communicated to the concerned teachers. This initiative has resulted in the higher efficiency and enhanced quality of pedagogy. All the teachers of the college use ICT tools in order to make their teaching effective.
