
"Jaipal Singh Munda Employment Oriented Skill Development and Training Programme" (13/05/2022)

Botanical Excursion Report

Context: Excursions are arranged to give exposure to students. Field education is equally important as classroom teaching. The tour applies study of environmental, ecological and local flora as well as fauna. It includes preparation of herbarium and sample collection. Department of Botany provides the compulsion for undergraduate students to attend the tour. Thus education tour is of vital importance as practical knowledge gained

Practice: As a part of B.Sc. Curriculum one day Botanical excursion has been arranged by Rashtrapita Mahatma Gandhi Arts and Science College, Nagbhid Department of Botany on 18th August 2022 at Ghodazari Wildlife Sanctuary along with Forest Department. Ghodazari Wildlife Sanctuary is a wildlife reserve established in 2018 in Nagbhid in the Chandrapur district of the Vidarbha region in Maharashtra, India. It includes 159 km2 (61 sq mi) of southern tropical dry forest and a lake. The forest is considered a key region on the connecting corridor for the tiger migration between the Tadoba Andhari Tiger Project and Umred Karhandala Wildlife Sanctuary. It is named after a village of the same name that is almost in the middle of the forest, about 2 km from the dam and the resort. In Marathi, 'Ghoda' means horse and 'Zari' means a place with a water spring. The tour was organized under the kind and expert guidance of our respected Principal Dr. G. D. Deshmukh Sir and Dr. Rajendra Chavhan sir guides about various diversity of birds and related fauna and Dr. V. M. Mohture Sir, Dr. Kayarkar Sir and Mr. Madavi Sir also guides about plants and various floral diversity.

During visit, faculties explain the importance of location, shown actual habitat, discussed & informed about all plants groups such as (Algae, Fungi, Bryophytes, Pteridophytes, Gymnosperms, Angiosperms) along with their taxonomy details which includes botanical names & its classification. Economic importance, medicinal uses, extinction of any species & other specialties related climate, temperature, composition of soil also. Non-teaching staff and students tried to collect and uproot those plant species which does not show its contribution in nature.


