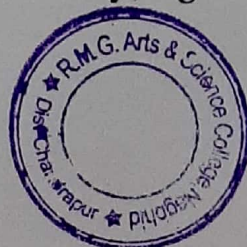


## Anti-ragging Awareness Programm


